- Workshops and awareness programs for students, faculty, and staff on data privacy and protection. Guidelines for safe handling of personal data and reporting of breaches

d) Compliance and Monitoring

- Institutional mechanisms to ensure continuous compliance with the Data Protection Act. Reporting and resolution of data breaches or unauthorized access incidents. Periodic review of data protection policies and practices

3. Coverage

- Applicable to all UG & PG – Engineering and Technology, PG – Computer Applications, and PG – Management programs. Covers all stakeholders including students, faculty, non-teaching staff, and collaborators
