Industry collaborations, MoUs, and linkages for internship opportunities. Guidance for selecting internship domains, companies, and projects. Support for student documentation, evaluation, and credit assignment. Monitoring of internship progress through reports, reviews, and presentations

#### **4. Internship Structure and Guidelines**

The policy ensures: Mandatory completion of minimum internship duration as per AICTE norms. Internships during summer/winter breaks or as embedded curricular components. Credit allocation and evaluation as per academic regulations. Submission of internship reports, certificates, and assessment outcomes

#### **5. Compliance, Monitoring, and Reporting**

DGI: Maintains records of internship placements, completion certificates, and evaluation reports. Conducts periodic reviews with departments and IQAC. Ensures that all students complete mandatory internships before graduation. Aligns internship procedures with AICTE Internship Policy and NEP experiential learning requirements
